# 4 – BUDGET Initial phase

Project Budget = \$16.00 Million \$14.5 million from BMGF \$ 1.5 million from AWF

- Component 1 : Fund establishment = \$2.9 millions
- Component 2 : Project preparation = \$7.1 millions
- Component 3 : Catalytic investment project → = \$3.2 millions
