











## Areas of reflection

Discussions will focus on the integration of innovative technologies to address water and sanitation challenges in Africa. Among these, seawater desalination and membrane technologies will be explored to ensure a more efficient drinking water supply. Intermittent water management, tanker trucks, and the development of wells and protected springs are suitable solutions for restricted areas. Innovations in eco-friendly toilets, sustainable fecal sludge management, and the decentralization of urban sanitation services complement this approach. The adoption of renewable energies and the circular economy in sanitation will also be at the heart of the reflections.



**Expected results** 

At the end of these three days of discussions, it is expected that:

- A better understanding of disruptive technologies applicable to the African context;
- Identification of policies and regulatory frameworks suitable for the adoption of these technologies;
- Strengthening partnerships between water and sanitation sector actors to support innovations;
- The development of strategic recommendations to integrate these technologies into national action plans.

In fine, achieving SDG 6 in Africa necessarily requires innovation and, the 94th AfWASA STC session will build this momentum by providing a space to explore solutions that will transform the water and sanitation sector, ensuring a sustainable future for Africa as a pre-platform before the upcoming 22nd AfWASA International Congress and Exhibition scheduled on 16-20 February 2025, same in Kampala, Uganda at the Speke Resort Convention Centre (SRCC), at Munyonyo.
